A Message from the PRESIDENT

After three years as president of Tanglewood's board of directors, I finally get to write a message in the annual report! Yes, it's been a crazy few years for sure — extremely sad for too many, and, at a minimum, frustrating for everyone. However, we do seem to be finally seeing the light at the end of the Covid tunnel. Looking back, I reflect on the fact that Tanglewood has more than just survived over that time.

I became president in January 2020, exactly two months before lockdowns began. I happen to remember it well because it was the year of a significant birthday for me; which my husband and I ended up spending eating a takeout dinner in our hotel room instead of at a restaurant with beautiful sea views!

I was honored, and still am, to serve as president of Tanglewood. It was one of the first places I visited when I moved to the area from the UK in 2000. I love being outdoors, hiking and birdwatching, and Tanglewood appeared to be one of the few places in the local area that provided free access — in fact, it still is. I also come from a Girl Scouting background (we call it Girl Guides in the UK) and the education of young people about the importance of sustaining the natural environment is important to me, especially with the growing impact of climate change. These key aspects of Tanglewood's mission are what drives me to devote much of my energy into supporting such a wonderful organization.

So, what is a Board president to do when everything is locked down and you can't even have face-to-face meetings or visit the place you're supposed to be supporting? Well, like a lot of organizations, we discovered Zoom and so meetings could restart. Having recently retired from a leadership position with Corning Incorporated, I was able to utilize my workplace skills to good effect. I won't bore you with the details but it was very productive and, personally, gave me a purpose during lockdown that I thoroughly appreciated. I think I would have gone crazy without Tanglewood!

The other key activity I volunteered for during this time was the development of a pollinator garden. Two things happened to drive this: Firstly, during the holiday my husband and I took in March 2020, we visited a nature center in Florida and saw what a wonderful garden they had developed. Secondly, when we got back to Tanglewood, a volunteer had started to develop a new home for Bernice, leaving the whole area between the aviaries an empty ground without a purpose.

So, I volunteered to design and build a pollinator garden! I also volunteered my husband, and for his help, I am very grateful. I also couldn't have done it without other volunteers like Forrest Meekins and Bob Petske, among others, including groups from Corning Incorporated and the Islamic Association of the Twin Tiers.

So, that's how I spent the last three years. Tanglewood has become an integral part of my life and I know that, for many who hiked the trails and visited the center when it was open, it was also a key avenue for surviving the lockdown. Now that we are coming out of the tunnel, it's great to see more people coming back and the kids enjoying being together again. We look forward to 2023 when we celebrate 50 years of Tanglewood — here's to the next 50 years!
